

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

The past twelve months have been a most significant period for the Adelaide Cricket Club. During this time we have:

- 1. Acquired the Park 23 permit and clubrooms, which gives us the option of re-establishing our headquarters within the City of Adelaide.
- 2. Obtained a substantial grant from the Commonwealth Government for upgrading the Park 23 facilities, which enables us to realise our dream in the shorter rather than the longer term.
- Successfully resisted a challenge to the long term viability of our club, resulting from the illconcerned proposal presented to the media by some delegates that we relocate down South and merge with Southern Districts.
- 4. Initiated a development program for Aboriginal cricketers in co-operation with the State Aboriginal Affairs Department.
- 5. Arranged a successful past players day which involved contact with some quality performers from our past.

These achievements are all additional to the 'normal' activities of a cricket season. They must surely represent one of the most concentrated efforts over the recent history of our club.

On-field performances were also significant. From an individual perspective we congratulate:

- Lee-Anne Hunter on her selection in the Australian women's cricket team; a huge achievement in any sport.
- Ben Johnson on being offered a partial scholarship to the AIS Cricket Academy.
- Ben Hook on winning the West End trophy for the SACA batting aggregate in A Grade; the first time for 17 years this has been won by an Adelaide player.
- Chris Davies for winning the Syd Daly trophy for performances in C Grade cricket.
- Karen Rolton and Donna Laity for selection in the women's U21 State side.
- Brad Birrell and Abel Podger for selection in the U17 State side.
- Daniel Worthley, Stuart Smyth and Adam Barton for selection in the U17 combined Shell Shield side.

A season in which we won five premierships would in normal circumstances be considered successful. As the premierships were not at A grade level we cannot be entirely satisfied with our season.

Nevertheless, we congratulate the premiership winners in C and D Grade men's competition, B and C Grade women's completion and the U17 Shell Shield. These were significant achievements by all those involved.

Many people contributed a lot to enable us to run a cricket club of our size and standing. My thanks to the Committee for all their efforts, particularly to the Executive, Robert Cairney (a well deserved winner the CEC Starr Award), Leon Milford and Jan Hinkly.

The support of all our club sponsors are invaluable. Particular thanks goes to Bone Timber Industries, Jardine Australian Insurance Brokers and BS Stillwell Ford for their substantial assistance.

We also appreciate the work put in by Steve Trenorden, Shane Bernhardt, the captains of all teams and the junior coaches and managers. A great deal of time and effort has been given by you all to improve the standard of cricket throughout our club.

Thanks also to the many people who help out around the club, with the clubrooms, grounds, managing teams, scoring and fund raising. The efforts of John and Andrew Ramage in putting together much of the sponsorship and awards for the season is also acknowledged. All these tasks are vital and we appreciate all those who contribute.

Next year is even more important for us as SACA moves to a pennant cricket competition. We have big plans and high hopes. I encourage you all to give your support to make Adelaide Cricket Club successful at the highest levels of competition.
