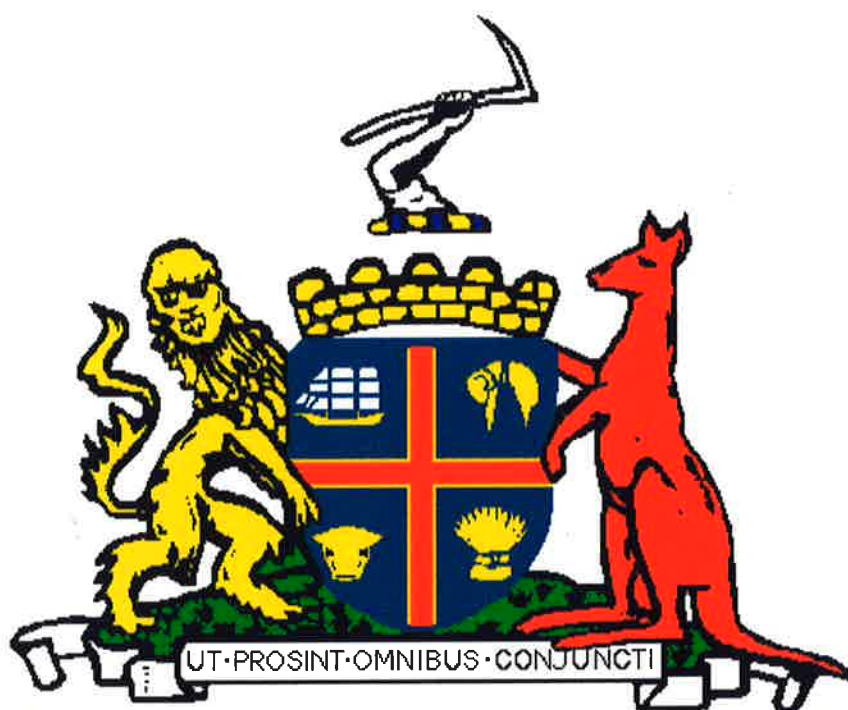

President's Report

After winning the Club's first A Grade premiership in 24 years, it was always going to be a challenge to repeat the performance. Although consecutive premierships were not achieved the Club still experienced a successful year both on and off the field.

The senior grades experienced one of the most successful seasons in 10 years finishing second in the Club Championship Award. This was also the season where the B grade won their first flag in 10 years and a young and promising D grade team dominated the competition. These outstanding team performances along with the strong performances from both the A and C grades, reinforces the depth of quality and talent the Adelaide Cricket Club has developed this season.

Although the A grade did not defend its title it did however reach the West End Cup final and record the highest number of Bradman Medal votes - again putting our Club in the spotlight at the highest level. In particular I would like to extend my congratulations to Warren Smith for winning the much-deserved C H Walker award for the best wicket keeper in the competition.

The senior grades can attribute this success to the development of a junior program that encourages players to strive and progress to higher grades. Again the Junior grades performed remarkably well with both the Under 16 Reds and Whites reaching the semi-finals. Both the 14 Reds and Whites enjoyed encouraging seasons with many fine individual performances, establishing a good base for next season. The Under 13 and 15 Sunday competition teams enjoyed promising seasons and were an invaluable resource for feeding players into the respective Under 14 and 16 teams.

The Committee this season was intent on improving the financial position of the Club. With much delight I can report that the Club this year was able to improve the balance of our investment accounts. This remains a key objective for the coming years to secure the financial position of the Club and importantly make it a power on and off the field in grade cricket. Many other improvements were achieved and introduced by the Committee this year:

- **Development of competition leading West End Cup one day outfits**
- **Introduction of a new look Allreunder newsletter**
- **Holding of a successful past players and sponsors day**
- **Leasing of Park 23 to the Adelaide Raiders Soccer Club during winter**
- **The relaying of new pitches for both practice and centre wicket areas**
- **Liquor licence for Park 23**
- **Encouraging discussions with Marion Council to redevelop the Glandore Clubrooms**

I would like to extend a thank you to all these members that contributed to the Club in one way or another, if this assistance is not forth coming a club such as this will not survive. In particular I would like to thank all team managers, scorers, captains and parents for the support provided to both Shane Bernhardt and Eric Freeman throughout the season. Congratulations and thanks also extend to my Committee colleagues who have achieved plenty this year.

The records indicate that this was a successful season, nevertheless let's not stop there but continue to strive to be the best Club in grade cricket. This will however only be achieved with the help and support of all club members.

CLUB COACH'S REPORT.

Season 1999/2000 will be remembered as the year of the Kensington Cricket Club; simply because they won the A Grade Premiership. Rightly or wrongly this is how Grade Clubs are measured and even though we can look back on a successful season, we will not be remembered as being the best.

Our season once again started in the first week of July with six players participating in the Fielders Steel Roofing Batting Development Squad. This season we were fortunate that we could also include an additional six players in the Inaugural Sir Ronald Brierley Bowling Development Squad. These players worked together over a period of six weeks leading in to the Club's pre-season. For the first time in my memory, we had to actually reduce our indoor training squad as we saw 72 players attend pre-season training. As you can imagine, 72 players do not fit into 44 spots all that easily and unfortunately, a number of individual disappointments were to follow.

The A Grade were now the 'measuring stick' of the competition following their successful 1998/99. A couple of close losses prior to Christmas cost us severely and even an outright win in the last minor round game was not enough for us to make the finals. We had to settle with being 3 points out of the four. In the West End Cup competition we fared much better by winning all three minor round games and defeated Kensington in a very memorable semi final. Unfortunately, under the lights of Adelaide Oval things didn't go our way and we had to settle for 'Runners-up Medals'.

There was a significant level of individual success worth mentioning and I speak of Ben Hook's inclusion as Captain of the Grade Cricket Team of the Year, Warren Smith's much belated Charlie Walker Trophy win, Erin Bernhardt finishing 4 points short of the Bradman Medal, Ben Johnson's West End Cup Medal win and Dale Agars finishing third in the Talbot Smith Fielding Award. We also saw Chris Davies strengthen his position in the State Team, Jason Gillespie successfully reclaim his State spot after recovering from a broken leg and Luke Williams and Shane Maraun let the State Selectors know they are ready for the next level after successful Academy and Second Eleven campaigns. Dale Agars and Nathan Woods also scored their maiden A Grade centuries. There is little doubt the talent of individuals in our A Grade side is well recognised throughout the competition.

The B Grade were simply fantastic. As with the A's, the B Grade suffered some close losses during the season and were often inconvenienced by a number of player changes each week as we tried to establish further A Grade depth at our Club. It wasn't until the last day of the season (in fact it was the following morning) that we saw the B's squeeze into the top four and as they say, "the rest is history". Lining up against East Torrens in the Semi Final and arch rival Sturt in the Grand Final, we roared home as B Grade Premiers. Paul Pasculli led his team beautifully and has left no doubt in my mind that a couple of his players are now ready for the important step to A Grade Cricket.

The C Grade finished their season much like the A's; only a couple of points short of playing finals cricket. If they could have found a further 50 minutes on the last day of the season, they would have scored the necessary runs to make the four. Once again, there were strong individual performances which ensured the B Grade could call on added depth whenever they needed. This certainly contributed to the B Grade's successful year.

What can you say about the D Grade? Skipped by Club Life Member Andrew Ramage, they destroyed every team in their path. To top the season off, they even won the Grand Final outright! Provided the D Grade side is used correctly, it can be a great grounding for younger players. I am certain Andrew developed our young guys coming through this grade in the best possible manner and have no doubt the depth of the Adelaide Cricket Club has benefited because of this. I congratulate Andrew on his efforts this season.

Naturally on field success doesn't just happen and considerable off field support is required.

I congratulate the Management Committee on the manner in which they operated this season and personally feel that under the leadership of Damien Kitto, the Club made strong off field advancements over the past twelve months. I would also personally like to thank Lyle Wheeler, Brian Cheesman, Bill Brooks and the loyal band of supporters who follow the A Grade each week. My thanks also to Alan Davidson for his assistance at training and along with Paul Pasculli and Andrew Ramage, for the on field leadership provided throughout the year. Finally to John Job and Bob Harris my sincere appreciation for your untiring efforts as Practice Captain and B Grade Scorer/Statistician respectively.

In closing, I ask you to once again reflect back on our B and D Grade Premierships; our A's and C's finishing a few points out of the final four; West End Cup Runners-up; the Under 17's, Under 16 Reds and the Under 16 Whites finishing one win short of a Grand Final; the Club falling two points short of the prestigious Club Championship Award; the highest Bradman Medal votes of any club; individual SACA awards to Ben Johnson, Warren Smith and Ben Hook; one player representing Australia; four players representing South Australia; one player included in the South Australian Under 19 team; four players playing SACA Second Eleven cricket; eight players in the Redback League; one player in the Australian Cricket Academy and two in the South Australian Cricket Academy.

Maybe in the eyes of some we were not successful this year, but I can assure you that we have set one hell of a foundation for the future.

If as players, coaches, administrators and supporters we can all give a little more and work as one to a common goal I have no doubt that season 2000/01 will allow us to successfully finalise this years *"unfinished business"*.

Ben Hook also chipped in with 27 wickets, bowling mediums and spin. This complimented his 500 runs and deservingly Ben was included in the Grade Cricket Team of the Year.

Congratulations also to Warren Smith on finally winning the C. H. Walker wicket keeping award. This was a very popular win.

To the B and D Grade, I also pass on my congratulations. Their achievement in winning premierships was well deserved and a great result for our club.

JUNIOR CRICKET REPORT WITH ERIC FREEMAN CLUB JUNIOR COACH

Premierships alluded the Junior Section of the Club this season after winning 2 U14 Red pennants in succession. However, the Under 16 Red and Whites both made the semi-final playoffs whilst the U14 Red and Whites both performed well and were in contention for the finals with 2 rounds to go. With up to 9 players unavailable for U16's from the end of January, for various reasons, the opportunity to promote players from the U14 ranks to U16's was a necessity and all players promoted performed well. Phil Maddocks, Shane Bannister, Glen Knott, Travis Wright and Scott Carman took up the challenge and although their absence weakened the U14 teams, the experience that all these players gained should stand them in good stead for next season.

Under 16 Red This team lost many players to promotion to the Seniors and School First X1 but performed admirably against the 3 top teams in the final rounds and with a bit of luck could have played off in the Grand Final. Captain Doug Fraser scored 350 runs and took 28 wickets, Matthew Kakeschke 346 runs whilst Ryan Kenopka was the big improver with 297 runs in the Reds and 127 in the Whites. The leading bowler was Hayden Cawley with 31 wickets. Andrew Montesi showed considerable improvement with the bat in the last 4 matches and although his bowling was disappointing at times, big things are expected of Monty next season. David Cunningham kept wickets in an excellent manner throughout the season.

Under 16 White This team was in top position for 12 of the 13 rounds but unfortunately lost a lot of players to promotion to the Reds and unavailability. Perhaps a lack of quality players affected the team performance as the season progressed. Dino Vryales led from the front scoring 359 runs and Nick Hamm scored 237 runs before being promoted for the last 4 games.
